

# What's Up With Vijaywada?

How did this get so bad so quickly?




We have to work on supporting these people.



"We need more hands to help move people to safety!"


"Yes, let us go to that area"



"But the people of Wayanad didn't give up. They came together, united against the destructive forces of nature."




"Let's start a campaign online to share our story and ask for help online"
